

Alraft of eighty six acres and eighty two perches of land with six per cent for Floads situate in Greenwood township in Mifflin county surveyed 28th September 1814 in pursuance of a Warrant to Elizabeth Flotes dated 12th August 1814.

Note, improvement at time of survey on the above represented land, a Cabbin house in which the woman to whom said Warrant was granted and her brother, a blind man, were in the habit of living, & a garden spot in a state of cultivation
