


Michael Frey.



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Robinson dated October 28th 1809 surveyed on the 7th day of May 1816 the above described tract of land containing ninety five acres seventy eight perches and allowance proportioned at six per cent situate in Donegal Township in the County of Westmoreland

N.B. The above described tract of land was apparently first improved in the year 1799 and a family of persons actually residing thereon previous to the 28th day of March 1814.
