

By virtue of a Warrt from the Comm^rs of Prop-
erty to me directed bearing date the 19th /^{2d} mo 1703
to lay out unto Joseph Paul 492 acres in right of
Edward Bleuman his original purchase of 1000 acres; SUR-
veyed and laid out unto the sd Joseph Paul in the right a-
foresd a Tract of Land in Plumstead Township in Bucks
County Beginning at a Post at Elizabeth Sands Corner, Thence
North West four pole distant from Francis Plumsted's line
three hundred and six perches and an half to a post, then
by vacant land North East two hundred and fifty seven perch-
es to a heap of stones near a small Run, Then South East by vacant
Land 306 1/2 perches to a Post at the sd Eliz: Sands other Corner, then by the
sd Sands line South West 251 perches to the place of Beginning, Containing four
hundred ninety two acres & fifty perches, Laid out the 12th /^{4th} mo 1704
