Surveyed on the 25th day of March A.D. 1745. by Thomas Cookson late D.S. In Pursuance of a warrant for 150^a Granted to John Adam Schilig bearing date the 20th day of March A.D. 1744. And now the above has been calculated, examined &c and found to be correct and at the request of the owners George Asper and Henry Jacobs, the same is returned for Confirmation the 14th day of October A.D. 1811.
