



In pursuance of a warrant of 400<sup>rs</sup> granted to John Strawbridge bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 was surveyed on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1820 the above described tract or peace of land containing one hundred fifty acres seven perches & allowance of six pr. cent for Roads &c, it being part 484<sup>rs</sup> 119 p<sup>s</sup> situate in renang Township ~~Township~~ Crawford County Pa & at the time time of surveying the same Elizabeth Coulter was Residng on the same, and there appeared upwards of 20<sup>ac</sup> Cleared & fenced & in a state of Cultivation.
