


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Washington (formerly Reading) Township  
in the County of York, containing as above set forth two  
hundred and twenty five acres, one hundred and twenty  
perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.  
Surveyed on the 7th day of May A.D. 1768, by Charles  
Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> late D.S. in pursuance of two warrants  
granted to George Stevenson each for 100<sup>acres</sup> & dated the  
14th day of June A.D. 1762. And now at the request of  
Jacob Sleider the present owner the Draught is exam-  
ined, corrected, calculated, and returned for confirmation  
as the official works of the said Charles Lukens—  
March 26<sup>th</sup> 1822.
