



Situate in Schuylkill township, Schuylkill County containing 208 $\frac{3}{4}$ & 146 $\frac{3}{4}$ E & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. which was surveyed unto William Schaffer on the 3d of May A.D. 1816 (by the subscriber then in the employment of James Mc Farland Esq. the then Deputy Surveyor of Schuylkill County. a Draft of which survey was then filed in the Deputy Surveyors Office, and from which the subscriber did now make the above Return) in pursuance of a warrant granted to him dated the 24th of January A.D. 1812. Copied, compared & Recorded June the 11th 1822.
