



Situate in the New purchase Pine Creek Township Lycoming County about half a mile west from the pine Creek Furnace on the road leading from the village of Jerseyshore (Lycoming county) to Cowdery's port on Allegany River and about fifteen miles from St. Jersey sore —

Surveyed on the 5th day of July 1815 in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Tomb Dated 20th January 1815, — No. 6069 — Containing four hundred & thirty Acres and allowance of six percent for Roads &c.

Note the improvement is cabin with a family therein about one acre land. —
