



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 $\frac{2}{3}$ of Land Granted to Dean Timmons dated 14th Day of April A.D. 1792 was surveyed on the 24th day of December 1829 the above described tract of land containing 401 $\frac{2}{3}$ 30 perches and allowance of six percent for Roads &c and that Adam Holliday was in possession of the same and there appeared to be upward of 20 acres cleared & under cultivation situate in Oil Creek Township Crawford County Pennsylvania.
