




Surveyed to Agness Simpson on the 30th day of March 1796

 of six p^{ts} Cent for Roads & including an Improvement on the Waters
 of Cherry Run adjoining land of William McKee and the Heirs of
 Thomas Simpson in At-Strong now Centre Township. By Warrant
 dated the 10th day of April 1793. By Alexander Taylor for James
 Ross Esq^e then D.S. as appears by his Draught in my possession
 which I have examined and find Correct.
