

A Draught of a survey executed April 22^d 1830 on a warrant in the name of William Scull dated 4th March 1793 Situate in district N^o 8 N.W. of the Allegheny River Deer Township Allegheny County. Containing two hundred ninety acres two rods twelve perches and allow^s of Six pct. for roads &c

Note. There is an interference with a survey in the name of Jonathan Miller (shown by the dotted line) of sixty nine acres three Rods thirty perches & al^s. Note 2^d By an order of the Board of Property dated June 21st 1799 a resurvey was made July 25 1799 and excluded a part of what might have been designed to fill the survey originally, not interfering with Ge^e Campbell - marked B.
