


UP THE WEST BRANCH OF SUSQUEHANNA RIVER

above the Mouth of Alder Run in Allegany

four hundred and six Acres one hundred and  
fifty Perches and the usual allowance for  
Roads Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> Day of April  
1797 for John Shyrin in pursuance of a  
Warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1797
