



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 17th 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Scull for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 Adjoining William Wilson to the Eastward and on the South Side of the Gonaquenessing Creek North and West of the River Ohio Alleghany and Gonawango Creek including a part of Said Creek Called Fish Pond Containing four Hundred thirty Six Acres three quarters and twenty five poles to gether with the Usual Allowance of Six p^r Cent for Roads.
