

Draught of One hundred Ninety eight acres, Sixty one perches of land and the usual allm. of Six P.Cent for roads &c. Situate in Armagh & Derry Townships. Mifflin County, Survey'd 5th June 1829, on Warrant to Samuel Smith dated 23^d March 1829 for 200^q Survey on Wt. to Henry Long of 29-Aug^t 1812 thrown off 6 July 1829.

Note above land appears to have been included by a Survey made 15 May 1815 on Warrant to John Brown, dated 16 Dec^r 1811, for 400^q.

Improvements, Stone house, about twenty feet Square, one & half Stories high. Occupied by Mary Ann Dwinney, tenant under Warranteer. Some Cleared land which appears to have been Cultivated, now Waste - Improvement made prior to 1814.
