

A Draught of a Tract of Land, Situate in Hereford Township in
the County of Berks (formerly called Colebrookdale in Philad^a County)
in the State of Pennsylvania) Containing One hundred and fifty Nine
Acres and 70 Perches of Land, and the usual Allowance for Roads: That
was at first by warrant of January 14th 1737 granted to John Sicklar Then
on the 3^d August 1744 by Vacating Warrant granted George Suller-
(To whom it was Survey'd by Edward Scull Anno 1749) who also then had
paid to the Secretary Richard Peters Esq^r The sum of Five Pounds in part of
the Consideration, and after Henry Derringer, Nicholas Nickum, John Yeackle Mathis
as Bastian Sebastⁿ Truckenmiller & Shoupe and John Miller, had each the Land
for sometime the same was at last sold to George Marsteller November 17th 1772
To whose Heirs the same is yet belonging.

*IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
this twenty third day of January 1907.*
