



In Pursuance of a Warrant Bearing date December 10th. 1813 was Surveyed to Benjamin Selders on the 13th of May 1814 the above describ'd Tract of Land - Containing one hundred & sixty three Acres one hundred forty two perches & allowance proportioned at Six Per Cent. for Roads &c. Situate on Chestnut - Ridge, in Unity Township in the County of Westmoreland To Richard T. Leech Esquire } P. James Murry D.S. Surveyor General of Penna. }
 N.B. The above describ'd tract of Land Includes an Improvement apparently first Commenced in the Spring of 1808, Benjamin Selders was actually residing there on at the time of Surveying the same J. M.
