


FORM NO. 1.



The above is a Draft of a tract of Land Containing four hundred and twenty seven acres and one hundred and twenty eight perches and allowance of 6 p cent &c. Situate on the waters of the long run in Allegheny Township Armstrong County which was surveyed on the 17th day of April 1808 (by James Ross a former D.S.) for Nicholas Wallhell by virtue of a warrant granted to him dated the 7th day of May 1799, taken from his Draft now in my possession which I have examined & Corrected. Certified this 30th day of Decr. 1808.
