

 the twenty eighth day of March 1748 to Jacob Wismer Jun^r
 & Joseph Wismer the above described Tract of Land Situate

 of six p C^t

N.B. This land was first surveyed to Joseph Brown by warrant of the 24th
 of April 1740 but he not complying &c the survey was ordered
 to be returned by warrant of the 22^d of December 1744 for the use
 of Jacob Wismer Jun^r and Joseph Wismer
