16th 1813. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Snively & Joseph Snively Junr.
for 400^a dated August 20th 1813 Containing four hundred & twenty four acres
& all on which there was when I made the Survey a cabin and a family
living in it but how long they had resided in it I do not know.
