

The above is a Draught of a Survey made Novemb^r 12th 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to the Washington Academy for 3.000 Acres of Land in Separate Tracts, ^{Dated the 9th of August 1793} Situate North Westward of the Rivers Ohio and Allegheny. on Connoquenessing and Slippery Rock Creeks (Adj^g a Tract Survey'd for Said Trustees Called horse Shoe flat) in District N^o.10. Colled Round Bottom Containing four Hundred Acres together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^cCt for Roads.
