


FORM NO. 1.



A draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Longswamp, and county of Berks, containing one hundred thirty six acres and one hundred and nineteen perches and allowance of six percent for roads &c. Surveyed for Peter Diener the twenty fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven, it being a part of a larger tract of one hundred and sixty nine acres and fifty perches and the allowance of six per cent. originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated October 11th 1738 granted to George Shufort.
