The part of Rodeberger's claim within the dotted line and enclosed in Thompson's Survey contains 32 A. 88 p. & allowance of six percent &c.

The black line claimed by Thompson appears from the growth of the marked trees to have been run nineteen, and the dotted line claimed by the heirs of Rodeberger eighteen years ago. Which of those lines were made by consent of the parties or whether of them I cannot say, the only improvement on the premises claimed by the heirs of Rodeberger is a field cleared on the south east end of the tract.
