


FORM NO. 1.



Draught of a tract of land Situate in Milford township Mifflin County Containing Ten acres and 124 perches and the allowance of Six P. Cent for roads &c Survey'd the 25<sup>th</sup> of March 1805. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Adam Thompson dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1804 for Vacant and unimproved Land and also agreeable to an act Entitled an act to compensate David Meade & others passed March 9<sup>th</sup> 1796.

NB almost the whole of the above tract of land appears Cleared and under Cultivation by Adam Thompson yet no dwelling house or place of residence thereon.
