

Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1820 for Christian Spayd the  
above described Island situate in the River Susquehanna in Swatara  
Township Dauphin County, called "Rodsons Wharf or Battery" a-  
bout two miles above the mouth of Swatara Creek opposite the land-  
ing on Joseph Heisters lower farm, and about six hundred yards  
from the main land containing One Acre and one hundred & six  
perches Strict measure by his Warrant of the 19<sup>th</sup> December
