



Situate in Chancery Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 10⁰ & Allowance of 6 Per Cent for Roads &c Being part of a larger Tract of 52⁰ & 80 Perches and Allowance of Land, which was Originally Surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 11th day of the 5th Mo. 1793. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 11th day of January A.D. 1793. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 12th day of December A.D. 1814. And now at the request of the present owner George Williams the above has been returned for Confirmation the 16th day of August A.D. 1817.
