



The above is a Draught of a Survey made June 3<sup>d</sup> 1833, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Christopher Columbus Verner, for ten Acres of land, Dated May 20th 1832 Containing ten Acres 891 perches and Allowance of six pr. Cent Situate in Amwell Township Washington County on the waters of Ten mile Creek, being unimproved at the time of Survey, excepting a small strip on the side next Fetherling.
