

Situate in the last purchase District No 4 joining the line of District No 5. Twelve Miles south of the line of York State containing One Thousand & 43 Acres Sixty three perches & the usual allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c. Surveyed the Twenty Eighth day of July 1794. By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollen Hoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No 4913. Dated the third day of February 1794.
