Situate in District N^o 6 in the late Purchase on the East side of the Allegany River adjoining Wilhem Willink and others N^o 2322; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christianan Van Eeghei, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinck of Amsterdam N^o 2324; dated the twelfth Day of December 1792.
