

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785, entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honorable the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 13th day of December 1785 the above described tract of 200 Acres of land and the allowance of six pr Cent for Roads &c. Nº 409 situate in District Nº 2 on the West Side of Allegheny River in Westmoreland County.
