

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled 'An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by order of the Surveyor-General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the second Day of December, 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads, &c. N<sup>o</sup>. 1283, situate in District N<sup>o</sup>. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
