



In pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of February, 1785, entitled, "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised the Troops of this Commonwealth;" and by order of the Surveyor General, with the approbation of the honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1786, the above described Tract of Five hundred Acres of Land, and allowance for roads, &c. N° 167, situate in District N° 2, on the west side of the Alleghany, river, in the County of Westmoreland.
