


Donation-Land, in District N^o. 6.Lot, N^o. CXIV

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785 intitled 'An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops by this Commonwealth, and by order of the Surveyor General, with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have surveyed on the Sixth day of December 1785, the above described Tract of Five hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. N^o. 114 situate in District N^o. 6, on the West Side of Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
