Note all this survey is taken by older titles except about 36⁹⁹ the most of it is taken by an Order of Survey granted to Thos. Askew & William Sterling N° 2046 This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract & from all interfering claims the 5th of Decr 1839.
