


**FORM NO. 1:**



By virtue of a warrant dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 1748 surveyed the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1823 to John Singsher the above described tract of land situated in Heidleberg township in the County of Lehigh (formerly Bucks) containing one hundred and sixty nine acres and thirty five perches and allowance of 6 percent &c and at the same time surveyed off a part thereof containing one hundred and thirty six acres fifty five perches and allowance aforesaid for Jacob Ferber.

The whole survey is taken from a draught of Geo. Palmer, the division from a draught of Geo. Golikowsky. Returned the whole and Jacob Ferbers part in two seperate returns.
