


FORM NO. 1.



The above is a draught of a certain tract of land situated on the waters of Kings creek formerly in Washington County now in Hanover township in Beaver County surveyed for John Swarengen son & heirs of Samuel Swarengen dec^d September 23rd 1828 in pursuance of a warrant granted to said Samuel Swarengen for three hundred acres of land at the place afforesaid including an improvement and dated March 24th 1788 containing 393 acres 109 perches & allowance of six percent for roads.
