



Situate in Monongaheri Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 47<sup>a</sup> & 39 Perches and allowance &c. Being part of a larger tract of 247<sup>a</sup> & 39 P<sup>s</sup> & allowance &c. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant for 200<sup>a</sup> Granted to Alexander Stuart bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1750. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land the 25<sup>th</sup> (dbl.) of April A. D. 1810 at the request of the present owner John McCracken who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
