Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land by William Kersey late D.S. on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> month A.D. 1785. And now at the request of the present owner George Beck, the above has been calculated examined &c. and ~~etc~~ Returned for Confirmation the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1810.
