



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries the Sixteenth day of October
1734 Surveyed unto George Trumbauer a tract of land Situate in Frederick
Township in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a post in a line of Godl-
ieb Hergers land thence by the same North West twelve perches and by va-
-cant land the same course one hundred and one perches to a post in a
line of Philip Totherak's land thence by the same and Vacant land North East
one hundred and fifty perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South East one
hundred and Thirteen perches to a post in a line of George Haan Land thence
by the same South west one hundred and fifty perches to the place of Beq-
-ining Containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of six & Cent
