



The Draft of a Lot in the City of Philad<sup>a</sup>, laid out to John Lownes in  
R<sup>t</sup> of Warrant granted to W<sup>m</sup> Tidmarsh 3<sup>d</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1742 (in right of Roger-  
Beck's purchase of 500 Acres) and Order of Council thereon ~~on~~ 7<sup>th</sup> Febru-  
ary 1785 Containing in breadth on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from Schuykil Sixty feet  
& in length 247 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet bounded Westw<sup>d</sup> by 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Southw<sup>d</sup>, Eastw<sup>d</sup> & Northw<sup>d</sup>  
by Vacant ground. Survey'd the tenth day of July 1786.
