



The above described tract of Three hundred and two acres and four tenths of an acre, and Allowance of Six p<sup>t</sup> Cent. adjoining lands of Robert Robison, James Glentworth, Joseph Wilson and others. Situate in Cone-maugh Township in the County of Indiana was Surveyed (as appears from papers remaining in my office) on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of June 1788. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Wolf, Junr. the 22<sup>d</sup> of March A.D. 1786. but had not been legally returned into the Surveyor Generals Office. Resurveyed and Examined the 20<sup>th</sup> of June 1829.
