



Situate in Chancery Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth Thirty three acres and thirty one Perches and the usual allowance of six Per Cent &c. Originally Granted to James Turk in Pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 20th day of November A.D^o. 1788 - Surveyed the 6th and 7th days of November A.D^o 1798 by John Forsyth late deputy surveyor and by him neglected to be returned. And now at the request of the said James Turk, we are desired to make return of the draught as the official works of the said John Forsyth late D.S. the twenty ninth day of June Anno Domini 1803.
