


FORM NO. 1.



Draft of Lot No. 102 in the town of Gaysport, Blair County Containing forty perches and allowance. Surveyed for David Caldwell the 27 day of March 1868. Being part of a larger tract of land containing two hundred and forty nine and a quarter acres and allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Van Buskirk dated the 31 day of May A.D. 1762.
