


FORM NO 1.



Surveyed May 30th 1867 to the heirs and legal representatives of Joseph McFee Deceased the above described tract of land Situate in Payne Township Indiana County Containing Ninety Seven Acres and Sixteen perches and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. it being part of a larger tract of land Surveyed on the 9th day of October 1789 to James McFee in right of William Todd in pursuance of a Warrant dated 2^d day of February 1785 Granted to the Said William Todd the dotted lines represents the entire tract and the parts of the same now owned by the heirs of James and John McFee Bounded as above described
