

VACANT

Situate a Mile & $\frac{3}{4}$ West of the thirty one Mile Tree of the line of Dist. No 3. on the waters of big Toby's Creek in the last purchase Dist No 4. Surveyed the Ninth day of July 1793 In pursuance of a Warrant No 2587 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven & Flutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam. Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 AS containing Nine Hundred and Ninety AS & the Usual Allow^e of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
