


FORM NO 1.



Surveyed on the third Day of July 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent, Situate in District N° 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River, adjoining Wilhem Willink and others N° 2541; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam N° 2544; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
