



Surveyed on the first Day of July 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink and others N<sup>o</sup> 2505; by virtue of a warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam N<sup>o</sup> 2506; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
