

Surveyed on the third Day of July 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent Situate in District No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Willem Willink and others No 2526; by virtue of a warrant to Willem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No 2528; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
