

Situate in District No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River adjoining Wilhem Willink, and others No 2999; by virtue of a warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam, No 250R; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
