

Surveyed on the twenty third Day of August 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per cent. Situate in district No. 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Willem Willink and others No. 2881; by virtue of a warrant to Willem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Eghei, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No. 2886; dated the thirteenth Day of December 1792.
