


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Pinegrove township Schuylkill county containing fifteen acres and one hundred and thirty perches and the allowance of six per cent, being part of a larger tract of two hundred and eighteen acres and a quarter originally surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1815 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of April 1815 granted Jacob Zimmerman. Returned this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1829 as the property of Henry Stein at his request.
